Central Baltic-programmet har 115 miljoner € att fördela inom fyra prioriteringar:

1. Konkurrenskraftig ekonomi
2. Hållbar användning av gemensamma resurser
3. En tillgänglig region
4. En inkluderande region med yrkeskunnig befolkning

Hittills har vi haft tre utlysningar, varav den senaste avslutades i februari 2017.

Under första och andra utlysningen lämnades det in sammanlagt 325 ansökningar, varav 67 godkändes.

Plastic waste pathways into the Baltic Sea - The project demonstrates how plastic waste in urban areas finds its ways to the Baltic Sea and becomes marine litter. Land-based sources count for most of the marine litter while rivers are major pathways feeding the sea with litter. As a result of the project the amount and inflow of plastic marine litter and hazardous substances are reduced in the Central Baltic area and the Baltic Sea.

Piloting a Nutrient Trading Scheme in the Central Baltic - In the pilot scheme, several proven nutrient abatement measures including e.g. mussel farming, gypsum treatment of fields, and fishing of cyprinids are implemented, which result in phosphorus load reductions. The project is of high policy relevance for the Baltic Sea region and has been nominated as a flagship project of the EU Baltic Sea Region Strategy.
